

Y6 Food Bank Visit

A small group of Y6 children visited the Bishops Stortford Food Bank this week. They learned about how the Food Bank works and the many ways it supports people in need. We also met the Bishops Stortford Mayor, Cllr Norma Symonds, and the Food Bank Outreach worker, Jane Towns (A previous Headteacher here at All Saints!!).

We are still collecting for their Harvest Appeal, so please do bring in donations if you haven't already.

Currently, they are particularly in need of the following larder items:

- Canned beans/spaghetti
- Canned meat
- Canned vegetables
- Dried pasta and rice
- Instant mash potato
- Long dated UHT semi-skimmed milk and orange/apple juice
- Long dated medium size boxes of cereal (Cornflakes, Weetabix, Rice Crispies etc)
- Cereal bars
- Bottles of squash
- Sugar
- Instant coffee
- Long dated packs of biscuits
- Tinned rice puddings & custard
- Pasta sauces
- Savoury crisps and savoury snacks,
- Sauces: ketchup, mayo, brown sauce etc
- Jam, marmite and peanut butter

As well as non-perishable food items they also urgently need any of the following toiletry items:

- Deodorants (male and female)
- Shaving foam and razors
- Shampoo
- Shower gels
- Toilet rolls & smalls of tissues
- Hand sanitizers
- Wet wipes

PLEASE REMEMBER TO NAME EVERYTHING!!

PE KIT – Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school each week. It does not normally need to go home and can stay in school! Please provide Trainers for outdoor PE.

Hair and Earrings – Please ensure long hair is tied up (shoulder length is a good guide for when to tie up) and Earrings should not be worn on PE days (unless your child can remove them by themselves). Taping up is only suitable for the first six weeks of piercing or with a medical note to say the earring cannot be removed.
