

We have continued to explore our value of Perseverance, particularly looking at the story of a family of refugees in the book 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. The atmospheric illustrations and child's viewpoint help us as readers to understand the challenges faced by families displaced by war and civil unrest. We also explored the story of Jeremiah with Fr Simon. He was tasked with a very difficult job and stuck to it, despite many setbacks – including being thrown into a well!

In classes, the children have been stretching their limits with challenging learning. It isn't easy, but the learning conversations I've overheard have been excellent – "I'll help you with that." "You're doing a great job, keep going!", and "Can I have another go?"

Yes, you can!






## Sharing Safeguarding: Social Media
