The focus over the last couple of weeks has been on how we support each other with the challenges we face. Following a story that included the phrase 'If you can't go over it, and you can't go under it, you've got to go through it!', we used the examples from the 2019 Y5 Brancaster trip to consider challenges we might face. We also explored the story of Barnabas (Acts 11.24), and how he was described as an 'encourager' – how can we learn from his example and be an encourager of others?

### **BMX Workshops**


