

Welcome to All Saints Nursery. Each half term you will receive a newsletter letting you know some of the things your child will be
learning and how we teach in the Foundation Stage. We hope you
find them helpful. Over the next few weeks, as we get to know

your children, we will be completing a baseline assessment of where the children are now and we will use this to plan activities that will interest and challenge the children. We will be continually observing the children and recording observations on Tapestry assessment tool and, after the curriculum evening on 16th October, you will be given a login to see these observations, comment on them and add your own.

Over the next half term we will be thinking about the story "Goldilocks and the three bears". Through this story we will be concentrating on the children themselves; what they like to do and their families. We will be thinking about how we treat our friends and what we should do to say 'sorry' if we make mistakes. We will learn about the similarities and differences between our friends and us. If your child would like to bring in anything relating to the topic, we would love to share them.

In our Literacy sessions we will be focussing on recognising our name and attempting to copy it. We will be looking at and sharing many books and favourite stories over the next few weeks. We will focus around the Goldilocks story and the different versions that we can find in our classroom.

Each week children will be given a chance to choose their own library book from our classroom to share with you at home - please make sure they are returned as we only have a limited number of books. If your child has any favourite books from home we would love to

share them in class. Please do pop your child's name on them to ensure they are returned.



Songs & sounds: Throughout the year we will be following Phase 1 of the DfE's Letters and Sounds programme. We will be identifying and copying sounds, using rhythm and rhyme in our favourite songs, playing with alliteration and beginning to verbally blend and sequence sounds into words. We will concentrate on a new sound each week and will send home a 'sound folder' to reinforce our learning. On a Friday we would like the children to bring in an object starting with that sound to share with the

class. The sounds for this half term are s, a, t, p, i and n

During our Number session we will be looking at counting and recognising numbers firstly to 5 and then to 10. Our sessions will be very practical and hands-on using a number of resources including Numicon, Duplo bricks, beads, counters, Compare Bears and others. We will be looking at the numerals and learning how to recognise them and to match them to the right amount.

We will also be looking at different sized objects and ordering them. Using sand and water, we will begin to explore volume and capacity.

Each Thursday we will focus on our knowledge of the World, especially through planting and tending the Nursery garden and cooking in our dining room . Unfortunately the resources and ingredients for these activities add up, so we do ask for a **voluntary contribution of £3 a term**.

We hope you and your child have a great half term with us and please feel free to come and speak to us about any questions you may have.
