Dear Parents/Carers,

As the new Headteacher here I have spent much of my time learning about the way things are at All Saints. There is a lot to learn! One thing that has stood out for me is the lovely way the children respond to each other and show the school values in their interactions.

We continue to explore our value this half term: **Courage**. In our recent Collective Worship with Fr Simon, we explored the story of Esther from the Old Testament. She had to show great courage to stand up to King Xerxes and point out the problem with his plan. Sometimes we need courage to do what is right.

This week, the focus has been about having the Courage to show Respect and treat others as we would like to be treated, even if this is very difficult. We have explored who we respect, what respect is and how it can be shown (not just to people, but also to things). This links to our need to show respect to each other at play and at work, and be encouraging, supportive members of the school community.

It was lovely to meet with members of the PTA this week, and learn about the many ways this fabulous group support the school. There are lots of exciting things planned for the coming year. Please do support them — attend events, donate, offer to help (however small) or perhaps join the committee group to help plan/lead future events.

Without this support many things simply wouldn't be possible. This year over £4000 has been donated towards school activities — Gymnastic mats, Netball posts, Panto subsidy (reducing the cost for all pupils), and a computer charging trolley. We are looking to develop our outside learning spaces (Forest School!) and ICT provision in the coming year or so and need your help! School Closure (Bad Weather!)

We only ever consider closing school if we do not have enough staff able to get to school to allow us to function safely. We will let you know as soon as we can, usually by 8am. You can get information from:

- Parentmail: We will inform parents through our school text messaging system. This will also be used in the case of school closure midway through the day (either due to bad weather or another emergency).
- **Everbridge:** This is the free Hertfordshire County system, enabling parents to view closure information for all the schools their children attend. Parents need to register. Please sign up through this link: https://member.everbridge.net/index/892807736725489#/login

Website: We will aim to update our website promptly, though will prioritise other communication systems that alert parents faster. You can find other information about school closure on our website.

• Radio: Please listen out for announcements on local radio stations — BBC 3 Counties Radio, Heart FM 101.7 (Essex, including Bishops Stortford).

Please do not telephone the school to ask – please use all other methods first. If lines are engaged, staff are unable to contact us to let us know if they can come in or not, which impacts our decision to close. If you do not receive a message from us and there is no message on our website, we are open. On snowy mornings and we are open, the registers will remain open until 10am to allow more time for you to travel here safely. Thank you!
