## Dear Parents,

We are now very pleased to be able to host safe online sessions for your children to meet with their class teacher and peers over the next two weeks.

The intention for these sessions will be to reconnect, say 'Hi!' and share something they've been doing at home.

If you would like your children to take part in the session, please keep reading to find out how this will work. They are not compulsory but may be a great chance to catch up with their class teacher and friends.

As this will be the first time we've ever done something like this, we do ask that you bear with us if all doesn't go to plan! We will know more about how much of a success this will have been after the first sessions this week. If any adjustments are needed, we will let you all know at that stage.

## Overview:

- Each class has been set a time for the meeting and this will be posted on the Stream in Google Classroom –please look out for it (from week starting Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June)!
- Each session will be with your class teacher and will be recorded (for safeguarding purposes)
- Each session will last approximately 20 -30 minutes.
- A link to the session will appear at the top of the Google Classroom Class page a short while before the session. We ask that you please don't click this as soon as it appears and wait until at least five minutes before the session is due to start.
- If you are using a computer it will appear as a link on the class banner.
- If you use an ipad/iphone/android device, it will appear as small video camera at the top of the stream or classwork
- Click on either the link or the video camera icon
- We will try to ensure the children who are in school also attend this Meet

#### Once in the session:

- Please remain with your child during the session (at least in the same room) in case they need support.
- The class teacher will say hi and may have some messages to pass on.
- Each child will be given a chance to say something, it would be great if they were prepared with something to share, maybe a piece of work they are proud of or something they have achieved while not in school.
- Unlike Zoom, Google Meets only allows four people to be viewed at one time without adding an extension. The video feed will jump to those speaking.

With any use of technology, there must be some rules to help ensure everyone has an enjoyable experience and stays safe.

Please read and follow the guidelines attached.

We really do hope that you and your children will love being able to join in with your class session.
