Out of the PPG children who attended the group, 50% achieved expected at the end of KS2 across all subjects.
1 to 1 support for children with SEN	Teaching Assistant support to deliver Individual Support Plan interventions to aid learning and progress.	£13,787	£14000	The majority of pupils with SEND receiving 1:1 intervention made positive progress in reading and writing and maths, with half making strong positive progress across all three areas. A small minority of pupils, who have more significant needs, are working below the national curriculum standard. Their attainment and progress are monitored using an alternative small step, structured assessment tool. For these pupils, targeted and responsive 1:1 support has enabled them to make strong positive progress in reading and positive progress in writing and maths, based upon this small step tracking tool.

Speech & Language Support	Speech and Language support to aid communication and language ability, using both Wellcomm and Talk Boost programmes.	£1,859	£1,400	Pupils made good progress in Communication & Language and good progress in reading and writing.
TA to support pupils' social & emotional development.	1 to 1 and/or group sessions to improve behaviour, social interactions and mental health/wellbeing, including Protected Behaviours intervention.] £3,738	£3,800	Provision through 1:1 work improved behaviour. Children developed strategies to cope with emotions and anger. Exclusions reduced over the year resulting in none in the summer term.
