Transport and Travels: are we there yet?

CORE SUBJECTS

Maths

This term we will consolidate the children's existing understanding by looking at place value within 10, including comparing, ordering and representing numbers. We will then move on to adding and subtracting, including learning the number bonds to ten.

After half-term we will look at 2D and 3D shapes and then revisit place value moving on to numbers up to 20 and counting beyond.

The aim of this term is to help the children gain a solid foundation with

English

In English we will be reading 'Kipper's toy box' which links to our History topic. We will be describing characters and then create our own toy character to join the story! We will then write our own stories based on the new character. After half-term we will look at poetry linked to fireworks and all that we see / hear! After half term, linked to our history topic, we will write non fiction facts about early air transport and then learn about letter writing. Throughout these writing genres the children will be focusing on writing sentences with capital letters and full stops, as well as using story telling language.

In phonics lessons we will be consolidating the phase 3

Science

Our first science topic will be looking at the human body and learning about the senses. The children will be developing their observation skills in addition to collecting data and noticing patterns.

Throughout the year we will be looking at the seasons and observing and describing the weather.

Computing

In computing lessons we will be learning basic computer skills such as typing, opening and closing documents and copying and pasting images.

We will also be learning to record and playback our voices linked to our writing.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

Music

The unit 'Ourselves' develops the children's ability to identify different sounds, as well as make sounds using voices and percussive instruments.

In the units 'Animals' and 'Seasons' the children will be exploring pitch using movement, voices and instruments.
