Spirited Arts Competition 2016 Art in Heaven





We are absolutely delighted to have found out that two of our pupils, Kiki in Year 3 and Maxwell (now in Year 7), have been chosen as some of the winners of the national Spirited Arts 2016 competition. The whole school carried out a special Art & RE project based on one of the competition categories - Seeing Jesus last July. The theme asked the children to record responses to the ways we can 'see' Jesus. In addition, it required the children to reflect on what Jesus *means* to Christians, as a different way of 'seeing' him.

You may remember our special Art Gallery in the dining room during last summer's Open Evening, where a collection of work produced by the children was displayed. Out of these pieces of work, ten were submitted to the national Spirited Arts competition. The different categories in the Art in Heaven competition attracted over 25 000 responses from children and young people across the United Kingdom. As well as the piece of art created, the children were also asked to write about their artwork. It was clear to see from so many pieces of work how hard the children had tried and what great spiritual thinking had taken place.
