Music


- Charanga modified plans

2 Targeted academic support

- Home Learning information for all parents
- Small group work, adult supported (particularly in Science)

3 Wider strategies

- Ensure the most is made of cross curricular links – topic projects through English etc.
- Re-establish routines and expectations
- Well-being greater focus – Yoga therapy and whole class, PSHE 1hr weekly at least, circle time, team building games/activities, craft tasks
- Collective Worship – Hope, Community
- Friday Collective worship as a school
- Increase resilience through short sessions
- Use tasks that have high motivation for pupils to help engagement with learning
- Provision of technology for PP children
