SCHOOL UNIFORM

At All Saints we want our school uniform to promote a sense of pride in our school and a feeling of belonging. School uniform identifies the children with the school, makes children feel equal to one another in terms of appearance and is not distracting in class (as fashion clothing might be). We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy.

The Governors have sourced a supplier that, from those available to us, provides good value for money and quality of clothing for parents. All items listed with an asterisk * can be ordered from the suppliers. All other items can be bought from local supermarkets/shops.

Our School Uniform:

Infants: Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2:

- Sky blue polo shirt, embroidered*;
- Dark grey Trousers / Skirt / Pinafore;
- Navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan, embroidered*;
- Dark grey or black socks/tights, (optional: white socks for girls);
- Black traditional school shoes (no trainers, open-toed shoes, boots or 'flashing shoes');
- Navy blue baseball cap*.

Juniors: Years 3, 4, 5 and 6:

- Dark grey Trousers / Skirt;
- White shirt and school tie* (optional: V-neck blouse for girls);
- Navy blue knitted jumper/cardigan embroidered*;
- Dark grey or black socks / tights (optional: white socks for girls);
- Black traditional school shoes (no trainers, open-toed shoes, or 'flashing shoes');
- Navy blue baseball cap*.

Summer uniform

Pupils can wear summer uniform between the start of the Summer Term in April through to the end of the first half-term in October. In summer girls may wear pale blue ¼" gingham, short sleeved dress/playsuit (available from most supermarkets/shops). Boys may also wear dark grey shorts in the summer.

We actively discourage jewellery in school. Pierced ears should be a plain stud only, which must be removed for PE (by the child – if unable to remove it themselves, then they shouldn't be worn for that day). This is for your child's safety.

Long Hair must be tied back – shoulder length is a good guide for when to tie back. Fashion haircuts are also strongly discouraged. Hair accessories should be in school colours – no fashion bands/bobbles please.

Nail varnish, make up or temporary tattoos should be removed before the start of each school day.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY LABELLED. Unfortunately the school cannot accept liability for lost items of uniform/PE kit. Unclaimed or unnamed items are stored in a clothing box in the main entrance. *Please check it regularly – once per half term the box is emptied and unnamed items donated to the PTA Second Hand Uniform stocks*.

PE Kit (All pupils) -

- Sky-blue t-shirt (or polo shirt in the juniors) with the school logo*;
- Plain Navy blue shorts.
- Plain trainers for outdoor games (not 'fashion' trainers or plimsolls please)
- For colder weather: Plain navy/black joggers and plain sweaters (no hoods or logos) may be worn
- Drawstring bag (optional but saves space in cloakrooms!)

Children will wear their PE kit on PE days in place of school uniform. This reduces lost learning time due to changing in class. Classes in Y1 to Y6 have PE twice per week. Nursery and Reception usually once per week.

Please note, at the request of parents and staff, we have now included details of appropriate footwear and cold weather wear to our PE kit list. These additions come into effect from 1st September 2019 and will ensure pupils can access lessons safely/comfortably.

Forest School Lessons

For these lessons we ask parents to provide an additional set of clothing from home – to be brought in on lesson days only (currently Friday).

- Wellies/robust footwear (it gets muddy!)
- Long sleeve top (t-shirt/sweater as appropriate)
- Long trousers
- Waterproof coat

These lessons are always outdoors, in all weathers, and active – if there's mud about, they will find it! Nursery, Reception, Y1 and Y2 have lessons weekly. From September, Junior classes will have lessons in half termly rotation.
