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Summer

CORE SUBJECTS

Maths



In Maths we are going to consolidate our work on times tables and learning more about multiplication and division

We will be making sure we have a secure understanding of the four main operations, in preparation for Year Three.

We will be beginning some work on Fractions and statistics as well as looking at how to tell the time.

Any practise at home of telling the time would be really beneficial.

English



During our English lessons, we will be looking at George and the dragon! We have already started using some fantastic character and setting description.

We will be doing some writing linked to our topic and The Great Fire of London.

We will really be focusing on making sure our handwriting is neat and clear, with our letters sitting on the lines. We will be making sure we are remembering all our full stops and capital letters and spellings all the 200 high frequency words correctly.

Science



In Science, we will start off by looking at plants. We will be experimenting 'What helps a plant grow?' We will plant our own seeds and have an opportunity to watch them grow and see what seeds thrive in different circumstances.

We will also be looking at micro-habitats and food chains.


Computing

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

Geography



We will learn the landmarks of London and locate them on maps of the city. We will think about whether they are a human feature or physical. We will also begin to use compass directions.

We will be thinking about how things have changed over the last 100 years in London.

R.E.



This term Elm class will be studying Islam. We will be thinking about Muslim worship, values and beliefs. to our own lives and Christianity.

History



In History we will be learning about The Great Fire of London.

Art



This term our focus is on sculpture. We'll start by investigating sculpture using Plasitcene—crafting different shapes and objects. We're going to use "The Green Man" as our inspiration to make a face from clay and then use found objects such as twigs and leaves to make the hair.
