It is absolutely vital that we continue to do all we can to keep school open for all pupils – no meet ups or play dates outside of school (lockdown hasn't actually ended!), masks and social distance, regular hand washing and staying alert for symptoms. This way school remains a safe place for pupils and staff – and their families, many of whom have not yet had the vaccine or remain clinically vulnerable despite it.


Part of the Puzzle


