SUBJECTS

Maths

This term we will be looking at place value ,first up to 10,000 and then working our way up to 1 million, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, statistics and perimeter and area. We will be using concrete and pictorial methods to help develop understanding.

This term the children will be expected to have rapid recall of all their times tables.

In English, the children will be learning about stories from other cultures which will focus on using speech and extending our character descriptions.

We are also going to be writing explanations and biographies and this will be linked to our work on the Egyptians.

We will also look at the narrative poem: The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes.

We will have lists of spellings for homework which the children will be tested on periodical-

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During the first half term, the topic will be forces; the focus will be on making it relevant and applicable to everyday

After half term, the topic will be materials. The children will explore the properties, changes, and uses of different materials.

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Ancient Egypt

The children will learn about life in Ancient Egypt, historical sources, and learn to place Ancient Egypt on a timeline. We will develop our questioning skills as we enter this fascinating world.

RE this term is all about the story of Creation in the Bible and how Christians interpret this in many ways.

Later we will also learn more about Incarnation.

This term we will be listening to a variety of wellknown songs which are uplifting or rousing. We will be improvising and composing our own chorus for these songs. Later on in the term, we will listening and appraising a piece called The Three Note Bossa and learning to play it.

This term, Year 5 will be linking their DT work to their topic work about the Egyptians.

We will be making our own containers inspired by the Ancient Egyptians. We will be designing our own container shapes and decorations and learning how to join different materials together.

This term we will be learning to use thick and thin brush strokes to produce shapes, patterns and lines. We will be learning about light and shade when painting.

A variety of artists will be used as inspiration such as Seago, Hokusai and Seurat.
