CORE SUBJECTS

This term we will build on the Autumn term's work by recapping place value and learning about addition and subtraction within 20. Then we will be counting, comparing and ordering numbers to 50.

Later we will learn about different types of measurements and begin to measure. record and compare amounts. We will also revisit 2D and 3D shapes.

To support your child you might like to practise the following words in context: Equal to, more than, less than, left, right, longer/ shorter, tall/short, double/ half, heavier than/lighter than, hour, minutes and seconds.

We will be learning the days of the week and months of the year. Please keep practising these.

We will start our topic by focusing on the story of The Three Little Pigs. We will be retelling the story focusing on story language and introducing? and!

This will be followed by our whole school poetry writing project titled 'If I were in charge of the world'. We will we looking at vocabulary and performance.

After half-term we will be writing a story called 'The train ride' which focuses on sights and sounds.

Then we will be writing instructions.

Throughout we will be focusing on sentence writing and remembering capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as well as using sound talk for writing.

Our main topic this term will be 'everyday materials'.

We will be identifying dif-ferent materials and their simple properties and uses. We will work on observation, grouping and recording škills. We will also carry out simple tests.

Throughout the year we will be looking at the seasons and observing and describing the weather.

In computing lessons we will continue with our ipad work to search for and create images of the different seasons.

Building on our geography work we will be programming beebots to move around a map and give instructions.

We will also be marking safer internet day with the theme of 'Together for a better internet'. To find out more visit https:// www.saferinternetday.org/ en-GB/

This term we will be learning a song called 'Rhythm in the way we walk'. We will learn the song and compose our own version. Then perform our own song.

Then we will be looking at a song called In The Groove which has been arranged in six different styles of music. Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Each week we will listen to and appraise the different styles.

In Spring 1 we will looking at the topic of Gospel and the good news that Jesus brings. We will be looking at some stories from the Bible and thinking about the messages they give and what this means for Christians.

After half-term we will be thinking about the importance of Easter and the bigger concepts of salvation and incarnation.

We will be learning about looking after ourselves and others including health, hygiene and money.

We will also be spending more time looking at different emotions and how we can deal with emotions like sadness or anger positively.

After half-term we will be continuing with our work on emotions as well as looking at healthy eating.

In topic we will be learning about the UK, including finding the main countries and capital cities.
We will be making our
own guides linked to our
castles topic.

We will also be learning about houses and how they have changed over time. We will be making comparisons between today and 1940s using the book 'Peepo'.

We will be comparing our houses with castles too. We will be looking at books, pictures and arte-facts to find out more.

In Art lessons we will be In Art lessons we will be making collages inspired by 'Castle and the Sun' by Paul Klee. We will then investigate different ways of making prints linked to the work of Samuel and Nathaniel Buck.

After exploring the different parts of a castle we will then make model castles. This will involve planning a design, carefully measuring, cutting and assembling pieces and evaluating the final piece.
